## ASA's Responsibility

- Allergy Services of America (ASA) and Physician Group enter into a Provider Services Agreement
- Adheres to American Academy of Allergy, Asthma, & Immunology protocols
- Operates under the provider's license
- Stands up a turn-key allergy platform
- Provides all antigens, clinical supplies, minor equipment and marketing collateral
- ASA Clinical Director reports to the Medical Director (Board Certified Allergist)
- Develops custom immunotherapies (subcutaneous and sublingual)
- ASA Clinical Director provides training to providers
- Recruits, hires and trains the Allergy Technician (AT), LPN or LVN
- Clinical Director provides daily supervision to the AT's
- Performs prick, intradermal, food, penicillin and other testing
- Clinical Director interprets results and develops custom immunotherapy
- AT mixes and administers custom immunotherapy
- Provides and maintains an Allergy EMR including IT support
- Maintains \$2M/\$4M Professional Liability Insurance

## Provider's Responsibility

- Allocates 150 square feet of space for an allergy lab
- Space to include sink, cabinetry, refrigerator and bio-hazard services
- Services to include utilities, Internet access, phone and EMR connectivity
- Staff supports insurance verification and benefit eligibility
- Bills and collects for services rendered by ASA
- Approves prescriptions for custom immunotherapy
- Maintains Professional Liability Insurance for term of agreement
